SEMINAR PRE-REGISTRATION

SEMINAR REGISTRATION

Early registration for the seminar will be on Wednesday, September 21st from 3:00 until 6:00 p.m. in The Inn at Ole Miss Ballroom Lobby. Registration will continue in the lobby on Thursday, September 22nd from 7:30 until 8:00 a.m.

SEMINAR

This seminar will provide twelve (12) hours of *continuing judicial education* for trial judges and twelve (12) hours of *continuing legal education* for youth court referees. CLE forms will be provided for those who would like to report their attendance to Tracy Graves at the Mississippi Commission on Continuing Legal Education. MJC will report the attendance of all participants to the Mississippi AOC Youth Court Program Director.

LODGING

Overnight accommodations for this seminar will be at The Inn at Ole Miss. The Judicial College will pay for one room for two nights (Wednesday, September 21st and Thursday, September 22nd) for those judges and referees who attend the seminar.
